On behalf of The British Blockchain Association (BBA), I am pleased to submit our formal response to the FCA's Discussion *Paper DP25/1*, *Regulating Cryptoasset Activities*. As one of the world's leading authorities on evidence-based blockchain and crypto policy, research, and education, BBA commends the FCA's commitment to engaging meaningfully with the industry, to shape a future-fit regulatory framework.

Established in 2017, The BBA is one of the world's oldest and most respected blockchain industry associations. We have contributed to several FCA consultations over the years, including our participation in the UK's first HM Treasury's Cryptoasset Taskforce (April 2018) in collaboration with the FCA and Bank of England. We continue to advocate for a regulatory approach that is proportionate, innovation-driven, and globally competitive, underpinned by robust scientific evidence designed to safeguard consumers while positioning the UK as a centre of excellence for blockchain and digital assets.

Our submission provides a detailed response to the questions set out in Annex 3 of the FCA DP25/1 discussion paper. Our feedback is based upon empirical and industry evidence, global regulatory comparisons, and the experiences of builders and innovators across the UK's crypto ecosystem. While we welcome the FCA's focus on consumer protection, operational resilience, and market integrity, we have also highlighted several areas where greater clarity, proportionality,

Our response reflects the BBA's commitment to fostering a regulatory environment that promotes consumer protection, market integrity, and financial stability while enabling innovation in the cryptoasset sector. I would like to thank our members, editors, advisors and partners for helping us draft this response.

The BBA supports the FCA's proposals as a vital step toward a balanced regime for stablecoins and cryptoasset custody, aligning with our vision for responsible blockchain adoption. We endorse requirements like statutory trusts and disclosure standards to enhance trust and stability but emphasize the need for flexibility to avoid stifling innovation. Key concerns include disproportionate burdens on smaller issuers/custodians, potential barriers to market entry, and insufficient guidance on dynamic risks like forex volatility or blockchain latency.

Highlights of Our Response:

- · Endorses statutory trusts and segregation rules to ring-fence consumer funds.
- · Recommends allowance for operational exemptions (e.g. de minimis issuer-held coins).
- Urges clearer definitions (e.g. "unconnected custodians", "material discrepancy").
- Supports use of omnibus wallets and DLT-based reconciliations, with appropriate guidance.
- Recommends FCA-approved training for auditors reviewing tokenomics disclosures.

Key Recommendations:

 Proportional Regulation: Introduce tiered requirements for small and low-risk issuers/custodians to avoid market concentration and support innovation.

The British Blockchain Association's Response To HM Treasury's Draft Statutory Instrument (DSI) FSMA 2000 (Regulated Activities and Miscellaneous Provisions Cryptoassets Order 2025 Consultation

1. Overall Assessment and Scope, and Executive Summary

We commend HM Treasury's proactive regulatory approach in extending the FSMA perimeter to capture key cryptoasset-related activities. However, in seeking to regulate a rapidly evolving sector, the definitions and scope require additional refinement to ensure proportionality, clarity, and operational feasibility.

The Draft SI demonstrates a well-calibrated move from principles to technical codification, with notable parallels to the EU's MiCA and existing UK financial promotion regimes. We welcome HM Treasury's invitation for technical comments on the draft statutory instrument and accompanying explainer on forthcoming statutory provisions to create new regulated activities for cryptoassets. While the DSI does codify a broader oversight, some areas remain high-level and open to interpretation. Our response highlights key ambiguities, evidence gaps, and policy considerations requiring further attention.

1. Amendment of the Regulated Activities Order

(Chapter 2B: Cryptoassets Issuing qualifying stablecoin)

1A. In Section 3 of Part 2, Amendment of the Regulated Activities Order (p. 2), the definition of a "qualifying cryptoasset trading platform" lacks clarity regarding whether both decentralised
